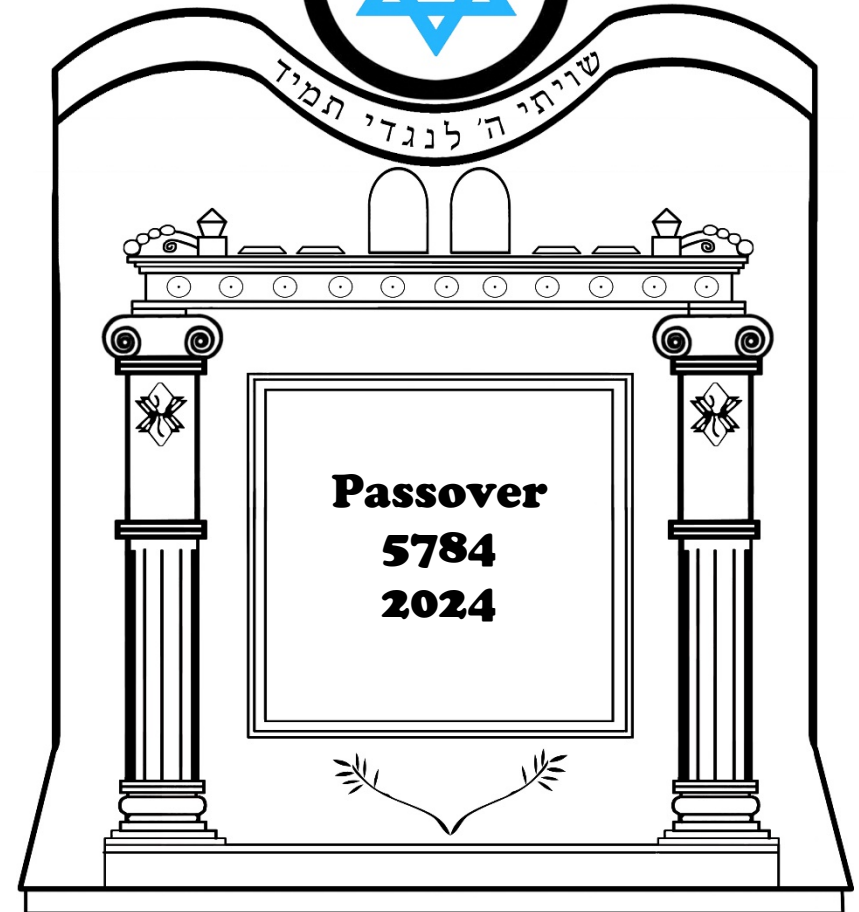

Shabbat Hagadol, April 20

Shabbat before Pesach: special Torah and Haftarah reading.
Friday Night, April 19, Candle Time: 7:31 pm
No Service Friday Night

Shacharit, 9am, followed by a kiddush lunch
Mincha following lunch, Shabbat concludes at 8:32 pm

The day before Erev Passover - Sunday, April 21

Check for hametz and burn it after nightfall

Erev Passover - Monday, April 22

Ta'anit Bechorim starts at: 6:24 am

Last time to eat Hametz: 10:50 am

Any hametz left must be burned / disposed of before 12:00 pm

Erev Pessah Day 1: Mincha/Arvit - 7:00 pm - Candles: 7:34 pm

followed by a Seder at 8:10 pm.

Passover Day 1 - Tuesday, April 23

Shacharit: 9am, followed by a kiddush lunch

Second Night

Mincha/Arvit: 7:00 pm – We start counting the Omer

followed by a Seder at 8:15 pm - Candles: 8:35 pm

Passover Day 2 - Wednesday, April 24

Shacharit: 9am, followed by a kiddush lunch

Mincha: 6:30 pm - Arvit: Following

Yom Tov ends: 8:36 pm

Chol Hamoed - April 25 to April 28

Services with Anshey Sfarad: 7 am.

Shabbat Chol Hamoed, April 26 & 27

No Friday Service – Candles: 7:38 pm

Shacharit: 9am, followed by a kiddush lunch
